PARISIAN WALK

"Fashionable Lounges, houses of sponsors and artists of the Plaine Monceau" was the theme of the Parisian walk proposed on Saturday, October 16th, 2010.

What an emotion to become soaked with the atmosphere of places as Ernest Chausson's former mansion (become the Embassy of Lithuania which we thank for its enthusiastic welcome), under the ceiling painted by Maurice Denis, in the presence of the descendants of the composer and Jean Gallois, his biographer! And to imagine the decorations of origin of Vuillard and Redon being next to the big portrait of the family Chausson by Carrière (Musée des Beaux Arts de Lyon)!

The walk walked then by the mansion of the Director of the Opera, Jacques Rouché and the house of the collector Jules Strauss, while evoking the places of creation of Cyrano de Bergerac (Edmond Rostand) and Pelléas et Mélisande (Debussy). Between the residences of Puvis de Chavannes and Sarah Bernhardt, the workshops of the sculptor René de Saint-Marceau and of Isadora Duncan, the exceptional architectural ensemble that hotels the neo-Renaissance of the street Fortuny constitute easily the fortunate Paris of the end of the 19th century.

EUROPEAN HERITAGE DAYS 2010





Created in 1984 by the Ministry of Culture, European Heritage Days take place every year the third weekend of September.

Cultural Event of the end of 2010, these days testify of the interest of the French people for the history of places and the art. The success of the demonstration rests on the big variety of the heritage proposed to the visitors: at the same time as the leaders of work of the civil or religious architecture, are put in the honour the witnesses of the industrial or agricultural activities, the parks and the gardens, the archaeological sites, the movable objects, the literary, river or military heritage...

A national theme every year

Since 1995, one or several national themes allow to federate the local initiatives, to bring to light a particular aspect of the heritage and to structure the communication of this event. These themes favour new openings and particular animations.

2010: The Great Men: when women and men build the history

The celebration of the illustrious men finds in France an expression privileged through a history of a big wealth the monumental tracks of which are still present in metropolises as in the smallest municipalities. The theme chosen as European Heritage Days 2010 will allow to illustrate the patrimonial places by the souvenir of the men and the women among whom the image, the life or the work are attached to it

It was thus the theme chosen by our association to illustrate Heritage Days 2010. The friendship between these two great men is particularly present in the soft and affectionate exchanges which we find in their rich correspondence. Among the numerous letters of Eugène Carrière and Auguste Rodin, it was not easy for the members of the board to make a selection to choose only about twenty papers, redrawing the feelings of admiration and respect that both artists had the one towards the other one. Furthermore, for a better understanding, the writing of a narrative text of the life of Eugène and Auguste also made the object of a particular work of writing.



After several repetitions in this exercise of reading, Françoise BOITE, Patrice GUIZON and Isabelle GUIZON, in respective roles: Eugène Carrière, Auguste Rodin and the narrator, presented during 3 sessions, the story and the words contained in these texts of intimate exchanges between both great men. During the day of this Sunday, September 19th, 2010, the Space Eugène Carrière was able to count 100 attentive listeners and conquered by these readings which, as they were able to announce it in the visitors' book, revealed them this friendship between two artists and the importance and the sincerity of which they did not imagine.

The efforts supplied by all the members of the board (writing of the text of story, choice of letters, lay-outs, staged by the readers, the reorganization of the museum for the occasion) were thus rewarded well, so adding a new and pleasant moment in the album to remember of the association.

IRIS Messenger of the gods


We recognize in IRIS the increase of a study for the allegorical figure intended to crown the second project of Monument to Victor Hugo (1897), in whom the poet seems standing: arranged in plunging position, it was then completed by a tense right hand, by a head and by a pair of wings.

The figure is however very previous in 1897 because it was enlarged by Henri Lebossé in November, 1894 under the title "Etude de femme jambes écartées" which it kept for a long time. Deprived of the head and one of the arms to concentrate better on the main part, with its spread legs and her sex which opens in face of the spectator, Iris messenger of the gods is not without reminding the "Origin of the world" of Courbet (on 1866, Paris, Musée d'Orsay). Rodin had maybe access there, thanks to Edmond de Goncourt who lives himself the picture, on June 29th, 1889, at a moment when he was in connection with Rodin whom he quotes repeatedly in the Newspaper.


The party of Rodin to present Iris raised upright, as suspended in the space, and in a almost frontal way, in fact a strong and triumphant image of the femininity, the promise of pleasure, life, but also mystery.

RESTORATION OF A PRINT

Drawing of Auguste Rodin, on papier vergé

Drawing exposed to the Space Eugène Carrière within the framework of the theme "Two men, a friendship: Eugène Carrière, Auguste Rodin"









- 1. Very dirtied, yellowed paper, with acid spots, presenting wide transverse tears, and numerous folds, tears and froissures ring peripherals, with loss of material(subject) on two angles.
- **2.** Dust removal, exfoliating scrub. Aqueous cleaning.
- **3.** The Restoration of the paper: dubbing on Japan paper, plug of the spaces (hole).
- 4. Final result.

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One thank you to Sylvette who donated us her impressive mastery of the restoration, restoring a new brightness in this work nevertheless well altered.
